Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS)

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) has prepared a Draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the Nanushuk Project. Development of the EIS will assist the Corps in determining whether to issue a Corps permit, issue a Corps permit with special conditions, or deny a Corps permit.

The Nanushuk Project has been proposed by Armstrong Energy, LLC (Applicant) and includes constructing and operating infrastructure and facilities to produce and transport sales-quality oil to the Trans-Alaska Pipeline. The project proposes placement of 2.76 million cubic yards of clean fill into 271.6 acres of Waters of the U.S. including wetlands, and temporary discharges to 5.8 acres of jurisdictional waters of the U.S. (Harrison Bay of the Beaufort Sea) for screeding activities at the Oliktok Dock.

The Corps is soliciting comments from the public; Federal, State, and

local agencies and officials; Indian Tribes; and other interested parties in order to consider and evaluate the impacts of this proposed activity (project). Any comments received will be considered by the Corps to determine whether to issue, modify, condition or deny a permit for this proposal.
